



Club rules V4 (draft)

General

1. The Rules of the game of Golf as laid down by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews will be obeyed on the Pitcheroak Golf Course, except that they may be modified by any Local Rules made by the Committee
2. Golfers must be properly dressed on the golf course NO DENIM
3. Collared Shirts (or roll neck shirts/ similar) and golf shoes must be always worn (during competitions) NO BOOTS OR FOOTBALL BOOTS
4. Dirty shoes must be changed before entering the club shop
5. Metal Spikes are not allowed on the golf course.
6. Each golfer must play with their own set of golf clubs and golf bag.
7. It's recommended that no more than four golfers to a group at any one time, PLEASE ALLOW GROUPS BEHIND YOU TO PASS THROUGH, IF PLAYING SLOW
8. All golfers must register and/or prepay in the club shop (unless teeing off before club shop opened, thus paying on return)
9. No trolley's, stand bags and pencil bags, allowed in the tee area/ green on any hole
10. Golfers are expected to be courteous and follow all general etiquette.

11. Harassing or verbally abusing other golfers and the golf course staff will not be tolerated.
12. Rain checks are issued if the golf course when conditions become non playable or safe due to adverse weather (course manager will decide this action on the day)
13. If due to adverse whilst on the course and the course manager decides it's too dangerous to play, a klaxon will sound from the club house to indicate to stop play and remove yourself and fellow players from the course
14. If you pre-book a tee time and cannot make it, please notify the golf shop in a timely fashion.
15. Our Pace of for 18 holes is 4 hours and 20 minutes (four ball – three and two balls will be slightly less) If your 4-some cannot keep pace, please allow faster groups to play thru.
16. "Cutting in" is not permitted at any time. If there is slow play, please approach the group in front to request a "play through"
17. Adhering to playing procedures set forth by the golf shop operation is always mandatory, i.e., playing off winter tee's, playing on winter greens, bunkers that are holding water, notification that there is a competition in play, which can result in slow play, etc
18. You may only play on the tees of the day which are Yellow (general play or competitions), Red (ladies) and White (Competition or for handicap's)
19. All bunker rakes are to be left around the bunkers, please use them to rake your shoe prints and club marks, Pitch marks must be repaired, and divots replaced IN ALL AREAS OF THE COURSE
20. Our members and guests are welcome to use devices to access the public Wi-Fi throughout the Clubhouse (see club shop for password)
21. We ask that mobile phones must be always silent on the course but may be used in medical emergencies. If it is for an emergency, please let your fellow players in the group know.
22. Please use the dustbins around the course to remove your rubbish, not the bushes please
