

<u>Membership</u>

- 1. Handicaps are computed under the supervision of the WHS in accordance with current R&A/USGA recommendations.
- 2. New players that have joined, must complete 3x 18 or 6 x9 hole's (with a member) to gain their initial handicap, once completed, you must record a total of twenty scorecards (to include the 3/ 6 cards initially) onto the WHS system per year. Failure to do this, will result in possible penalty scores and disciplined by the handicap committee
- 3. Existing members (once renewed) will require a minimum of twenty cards per season (12 months), entered into WHS, again failure do to this in the allocated time will result in possible penalty scores and disciplined by the handicap committee
- Scorecards will be checked prior to being entered for competitions, any that are found to be not to standard (see attached) will be deemed as DQ
- All Members and their Guests or visitors with a R&A/USGA approved handicap may participate in club tournaments. The handicap committee may review all handicaps submitted and keep records of all entries into RKGC
- 6. The Club reserves the right to adjust handicaps for Club tournament play. The Club reserves the right to deny any Member or Guest entry into tournament play for handicap manipulation.

- 7. General play scores must now be recorded in accordance with R&A/USGA rules, either via the EG app or a completed scorecard, left at the club shop. Once you have booked a tee time (via the club shop), this is an intent to play, thus, you must put a general play scorecard in, the scorecards will be collected as and when. Any player not carrying out this practice will be disciplined under membership rules.
- 8. As per the R&A rules for competitions, a player registers his/ her intent to play, either through Stuart Gorton or Glynne Harris, depending which competition you are wanting to enter (Monday or Friday Glynne Harris or nominated player or Saturday's and Sunday's Stuart Gorton or nominated player). The cut off on a Sunday is 18:00. Any scorecards put in after that will be treated and entered as "General Play"
- 9. Any player that has entered a competition AND NOT entered their scorecard via the channels (as above) will be disciplined by the committee
- 10. Any player that fails to attend on either a Saturday or Sunday morning, without a valid excuse, once they have been allocated a tee time for either day, will be disciplined by the committee
- 11. Saturday competitions are drawn out of the hat on a Thursday at 18:00, any players wishing to express a tee time prior to this time may do so, with again prior consultation
- 12. Any players wishing to play in their own three ball/ four ball, may do so, but NOT in allocated time set aside for RKGC time on a Saturday or Sunday
- 13. Any player that has entered a competition AND NOT entered their scorecard via the channels (as above) will be disciplined by the committee
- 14. Golfers are expected to be courteous and follow all general etiquette
- 15. Harassing or verbally abusing other golfers and the golf course staff will not be tolerated, via any means, direct or club social media
